Occasionally, you might receive a "Behavior Incident Form" regarding your child's behavior. This can be perceived as a negative report; however, it's actually a means of communication between school and home. It informs you of a situation in which an appropriate choice has not been made. *Although the situation has been addressed at school, your support and reinforcement at home is appreciated.*
