Miller's Corner/Exxon: Dyed Diesel \$3.96/Gallon; On-Road Diesel \$3.95/Gallon; Unleaded \$3.16/Gallon

Town Pump/Conoco: (Requires use of WEX card as per current District practice) Bid consists of a \$.14 per gallon discount based on posted street price the day of purchase applicable at any Town Pump in the state This discount also applies to activity buses travelling for away events

Following discussion of terms, bus barn preferences, the posted price on the date noted and the benefit to activity budgets, Ms. Dey moved and Mr. Marker seconded the motion to approve Town Pump to serve as the 2022-2023 gas/fuel vendor. The motion passed unanimously.

* 2022-2023 ELEMENTARY DISTRICT #5 AND HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT #1 FINAL BUDGET HEARING:

- Clerk Beyer and Assistant Business Manager Click presented the 2022-23 budgets for condiseration. The High School budget was complete but additional finalization was needed on the Elementary Budget
- Following review of distribution of projected oil and gas revenue, current taxable valuation numbers and mill levies as compared to 2021-2022, the Trustees elected to continue the final budget hearings for both Districts until 5:30 PM on Monday, August 15, 2022

* PROJECT UPDATES:

- Removal of carpet at the West Side library resulted in tiles coming up. The project was immediately halted awaiting abatement of the flooring for asbestos. A proposal has been received from Tetratech regarding said abatement. The abatement price quoted is \$12,950. They have actually scheduled us for the end of the month. Once the abatement is successfully performed, the flooring installation will be continued and the library open to students. Opening of the library will be delayed about 2-3 weeks
